

Whitstable Cricket Club ECB Guidelines on Changing Rooms



& Shower Facilities

Whitstable Cricket Club has adopted best practice principles as advised by the ECB. Wherever possible the following guidelines should be adhered to:

- Adults must not change, or shower, at the same time using the same facility as children or young people under the age of 16 if the same changing room is used then they must have different times.
- If adults, children and young people need to share a changing facility, they must do so at different times.
- Mixed gender teams must have access to separate male and female changing rooms and must not use the same changing facilities.
- Due to the risks of inappropriate photography or filming, mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms

If children or young people are uncomfortable changing or showering at the club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so and suggest instead that they may change and shower at home.

When playing away fixtures at other grounds, please raise any concerns about facilities or behaviour that do not adhere to our own guidelines and those of the ECB, firstly to the playing captain and/or club representative in the first instance and the Club Welfare Officer if necessary. If such issues are raised, please ensure Steve Wynn, (Whitstable CC Welfare Officer) is made aware.
